Here's you chance to do some good old fashioned Twelfth Step work.

The district is creating a Twelfth Step list of volunteers willing to carry the message of A.A. to those who still suffer in local hospitals and institutions. All that is required is a desire to carry the message of Alcoholics Anonymous. Upon request, volunteers of same gender and approximate age will be sent in pairs to make personal contact. If you don't know what a Twelfth Step call is, ask your sponsor.

In addition, we are also forming a Bridging the Gap (BTG) list. Bridging the Gap is a program designed to connect people coming out of institutions and new to A.A. in our community with sober members. The responsibilities include correspond with those requesting a contact, getting them to their first few meetings and introducing them to the fellowship. (This is not a temporary sponsorship program.)

BTG will be separate from the 12th Step list.
